#### Dear Parents, Students, Families and Staff.

We have really hit the ground running this term with teachers and students in an educational fervour as they worked through their initial assessments and getting into their daily routines. The election process is managed by the Principal, with the successful representative commencing Term 2 2024, joining the continuing existing members. I am now calling for nominations from parents and carers who have children in our school. Nomination is either by self-nomination with the signature of another parent/carer, or by a parent/carer nominating you and you signing the form below to indicate your acceptance. Forms are also available at the Administration Office and will be sent home as well.

Nominations should be forwarded to Kim Kehoe, Principal, by 3.30pm Friday the 16<sup>th</sup> of February 2024.


